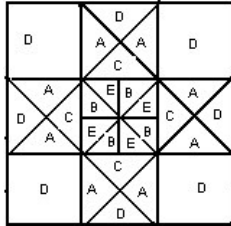




Ohio Star Variations Block 10





Pinwheel Star #10



12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.


- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Do not stretch bias points if at all possible, this will make it very hard to match points.
- Square up all 9 patches to 4 1/2".

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart


- A. Blue large print Floral: Cut 2 squares 5 1/4". 
- B. Blue Solid Stars: Cut 2 sqs. 2 7/8" 
- C. Blue sm. Cream floral: Cut 1 sq. 5 1/4" 
- D. Cream Solid: Cut 4 squares 4 1/2", and one square 5 1/4". 
- E. Cream Dots: Cut 2 squares 2 7/8"

ASSEMBLY

1. Four Point Triangles.

- A. Follow Quick Method for making 4 point triangles. 
- B. Use 1 AC (Lg Blue floral & sm blue floral) 5 1/4" square to make 1 set, and make 1 AD (Blue floral and Cream) 5 1/4" square to make 2nd set. Draw lines, sew "X".
- C. Cut apart and sew half of 2 point square using 1 of each color set.

2. Center:

- A. Follow General Instructions Quick Method 2.
- B. Make 2 triangle squares. Using 2 BE 2 7/8" pieces. 
- C. Draw center line and sew then cut.
- D. You will have 4 triangle squares. Line up the center seam points and sew 4 patch together. (Pin the heart of each point if desired). Be careful when making pinwheel. Do seams flip-flop so you can wiggle them together.

3. Lay out all pieces of the block.

- A. Make sure the Light Cream Dots point toward the center gold seeds.
- B. Solid Cream forms the outside cream tile ring.
- C. Sew rows together as in diagram above.
