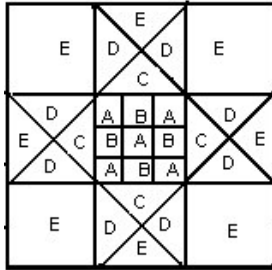




Ohio Star Variations Block 12




**Dolly Madison Ohio Star #12**



12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.


- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- *Do not stretch bias points* if at all possible, this will make it very hard to match points.
- Square up all 9 patches to 4 1/2".

**Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart**

- A. White w/cream dots: Cut 5 squares 1 7/8".
- B. Gold Seeds: Cut 4 sqs. 1 7/8"
- C. Gold floral print: Cut 1 sq. 5 1/4". 
- D. Blue Solid Stars, Points: Cut 2 squares 5 1/4". 
- E. Cream solid, Corners: Cut 1 sq. 5 1/4"  and cut 4 squares 4 1/2".

**ASSEMBLY**

1. Four Point Triangles.

- A. Follow Quick Method for making 4 point triangles. 
- B. Use 1 CD (Gold floral & blue solid) 5 1/4" square to make 1 set, and make 1 DE (Blue solid and Cream) 5 1/4" square to make 2<sup>nd</sup> set. Draw lines, sew "X".
- C. Cut apart and sew half of 2 point square using 1 of each color set.

2. Center:

- A. Using A and B fabric 1 7/8" pieces make center 9 patch.
- B. Sew two rows with gold in the center and 1 row with gold on outside.
- C. Sew two points made above to center piece.

3. Lay out all pieces of the block according to diagram and sew. Congratulations! You've done it! We hope you enjoyed this as much as we have.
