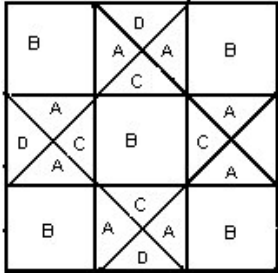


Block of the Month OH Variations

#1 Ohio Star



12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.

- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Sew & press seams away from the center piece.
- Do not stretch bias points if at all possible, this will make it very hard to match points.

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart

- A. Dark Points, Blue Stars solid: Cut 2 squares 5 1/4"
- B. Center, Blue small floral print: Cut 1 Square, 4 1/2"
- C. Medium, Roses Light Blue: Cut 1 square 5 1/4"
- D. Corners: Light Cream speckled: Cut 1 square 5 1/4" and 4 squares 4 1/2" for four corners.



ASSEMBLY

- Follow the "Quick method for making 4 triangle points." On Ohio star General Instructions.
- Use large 5 1/4" squares. Place one A facedown onto C and D face up. Draw diagonal lines and sew and trim away.
- Sew triangles together. AC with AD to form 4 squares of triangles. Match seam perfectly in the center. Pin seam points together if needed.
- Sew 2 D squares to each side of one AC, AD block. Attach D corners to A sides to make the Row 1. Repeat the make Row 3. Making sure C faces the center on each.
- Sew 2 triangle patch squares to center B, making sure C side of block is attached to center.
- Sew rows together as in diagram above. Match corner points perfectly. Place a pin in front point and match to back point then weave pin through fabric at each seam. DO NOT SEW OVER PINS! This can damage machines. Ease in seams to force points to be perfect.
