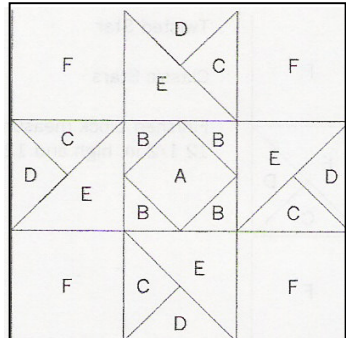




Ohio Star Variations Block 3




Twisted Star # 3

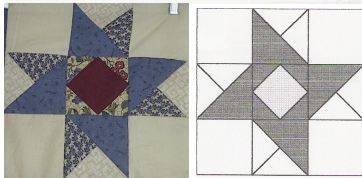


12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.

- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Do not stretch bias points if at all possible, this will make it very hard to match points.

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart

- A. Center Maroon Flecks: Cut 1 square, 3 3/8"
- B. Center Corners, Gold Floral: Cut 1 Square 4" 
- C. Blue Floral: Cut 1 square 5 1/4" 
- D. Cream: Cut 1 square 5 1/4"
- E. Blue Star Solid Points: Cut 2 squares 4 7/8" 
- F. Cream: Cut 4 squares 4 1/2"



ASSEMBLY

- Center: Cut "X" from "B" making 4 triangles.
 - Sew "B" triangles to "A" maroon center square. Long side of triangle to each side of square.
 - Square up to 4 1/2".
- Half of 4 point triangles.
 - Follow Quick Method for making 4 point triangles but don't sew these together. Use "CD" 5 1/4" squares. Draw lines, sew & cut "X" (light Dark triangles made.)
 - Lay out blocks to form the twisted star in diagram above.
 - Sew Light & Dark triangles to "E" triangles to form the two points as show in diagram. Square up to 4 1/2".
- Sew F corners onto top twisted point.
- Sew twisted points squares to each side of center. Be sure the long blue side is next to the center and the cream is on the outside of the block as in diagram.
- Sew rows together as in diagram above.
