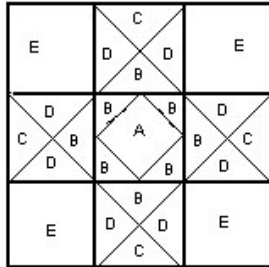




OHIO Star Variations 4

Gold Harvest Fields # 4

12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.



- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Do not stretch bias points if at all possible, this will make it very hard to match points.
- Wiggle back and forth with seams folded opposite each other to get a perfect set. Pin points together if needed.

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart

A. Center - Red Center: Cut 1 square 3 3/8"

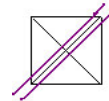
B. Center Corners Green Floral: 1 square 4"



and Cut 1 square 5 1/4".

C. Cream Dots/Yellow: Cut 1 square 5 1/4".

D. Gold Seeds: 2 squares 5 1/4"



E. Cream Solid: 4 squares 4 1/2".

ASSEMBLY

- Center: Cut "X" from "B" making 4 triangles.
 - Sew "B" triangles to "A" maroon center square. Long side of triangle to each side of square.
 - AB Diamond made, square up to 4 1/2".
- Follow the "Quick method for making 4 triangle points." On Ohio star General Instructions.
 - Use 5 1/4" squares BD and CD, draw diagonal lines, sew and cut.
 - Sew BD and CD triangles together to form point squares.
- Sew point squares to opposite sides of center AB Diamond placing B print next to B corners to form a diamond around the center following diagram.
- Corners: Sew 2 E cream solids to each gold side of the remaining to point squares.
- Sew rows together following diagram.
