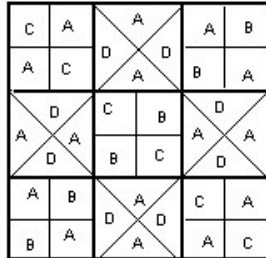




Ohio Star Variations Block 6

Chained Star # 6



12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.


- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Do not stretch bias points if at all possible.
- Square up all 9 patches to 4 1/2".

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart

- A. Cream Solid: Cut 2 squares 5 1/4" and (18, 2 1/2" squares or 2, 2 1/2" x 10" pieces).
- B. Red Chain: Cut 1 rectangle 2 1/2" x 5" and cut 1 rectangle 2 1/2" x 10".
- C. Lighter Green : Cut 1 rectangle 2 1/2" x 5" and cut 1 rectangle 2 1/2" x 10".
- D. Dark Green Points: Cut 2 squares 5 1/4"



ASSEMBLY

- Center: Using B red & C lighter green fabric.
 - A. Place BC (2 1/2" x 5") small rectangles together and sew 1/4" seam down one side, using a tight stitch length.
 - B. Cut strips apart into 2 1/2" sewn sets, making 2, two patches.
 - C. Sew red squares opposite each other kiddie-corner or checkerboard fashion.
 - D. Square up to 4 1/2"
- Four Point Triangles.
 - A. Follow Quick Method for making 4 point triangles. 
 - B. Using 2 "AD" 5 1/4" squares. Draw lines and sew "X".
 - C. Sew these Green and cream triangles together making 4 two point squares.
- Corners: 2 Red Chain, 2 Green Chain.
 - A. Place AB large rectangles (2 1/2" x 10") together and sew 1/4" seam down one side, using a tight stitch length.
 - B. Cut strips apart into 2 1/2" sewn sets, making 4, two patches.
 - C. Follow instructions above (1.C.D.) and diagram for color placement.
 - D. Repeat to make Green Chain using colors AC.
- Lay out all pieces of the block.
 - A. Make sure the red chain and light green chain form an "X" down center block
 - B. Sew rows together as in diagram above.
