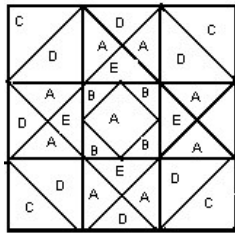
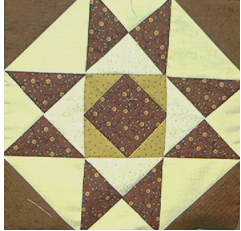




Ohio Star Variations Block 8





Tiled Star #8



12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.


- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Do not stretch bias points if at all possible, this will make it very hard to match points.
- Square up all 9 patches to 4 1/2".

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart


- A. Red w/gold seeds: Cut 1 square 3 3/8", & 2 squares 5 1/4". 
- B. Gold seeds: Cut 1 sq. 4" divide diagonally 
- C. Red Solid: Cut 2 squares 4 7/8" 
- D. Cream Corners: Cut 2 squares 4 7/8", and one square 5 1/4". 
- E. White w/dots (3rd from Center): Cut 1 square 5 1/4".

ASSEMBLY


1. Four Point Triangles.

- A. Follow Quick Method for making 4 point triangles. 
- B. Use 1 AD (Red w/gold seeds & cream solid) 5 1/4" square to make 1 set, and 1 AE (Red w/gold seed and white dots) 5 1/4" square to make 2nd set. Draw lines, sew "X".
- C. Cut apart and sew half of 2 point square using 1 of each color set.

2. Center:

- A. From B, cut 4" square and "X" lines. 
- B. Finger press center in both directions to form "+" line.
- C. Line up long sides of B (gold triangles) to sides of C (Red solid Center square) and also center point to center folded lines and sew.
- D. Sew 2 opposite sides of center (left & right) first. Finger press open and align the opposite (top & bottom triangles).
- E. Remember when sewing seams to this block align the heart of the point to the 1/4" seam line. Sew with this piece up if possible so you can see the "V" point you must sew over.

3. Corners

- A. Follow General Instructions Quick Method 2.
- B. Make 2 triangle squares. Using 2 DC 4 7/8" pieces. 
- C. Draw center line and **sew** then cut.
- D. You will have 4 triangle squares. Trim points if desired. Line up the center seam points and sew 4 patch together. (Pin the heart of each point if desired).

4. Lay out all pieces of the block.

- A. Make sure the Light Cream Dots point toward the center gold seeds.
- B. Solid Cream forms the outside cream tile ring.
- C. Sew rows together as in diagram above.
