

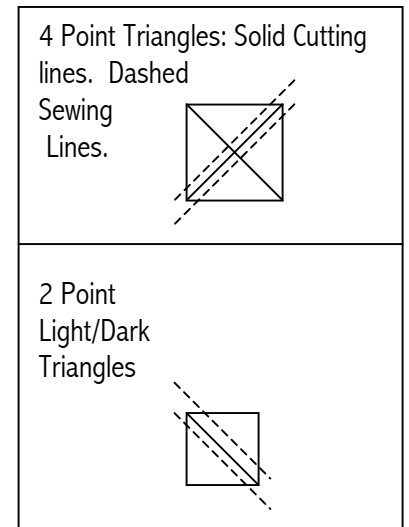


## Ohio Star Variations General Instructions & Star Set Together

Ohio Star, Basic 9 Patch. 12 Blocks 12" with 4" sashing between blocks. Quilt 52" x 68"

This block is basic, you will have 9 patches of 4 1/2" each. Square up pieces to this size.

1. Quick method for making **4 triangle points**. (Most blocks use 2, 5 1/4" squares).
  - a. Place fronts together, on the light fabric draw an "X" from corner to corner down the center on one line draw a 1/4" sewing line on the top and bottom of this line.
  - b. Sew on these lines. Cut the center "X" lines.
  - c. This will form two each of opposite sides of a 4 patch or 8 light and dark triangles.
2. Quick method for making **2 point triangles**.
  - a. Place fronts of fabric together.
  - b. Draw cutting line diagonally down center from one corner to the other.
  - c. Draw a 1/4" sewing line on each side of the center line.
  - d. Cut down the center line.



### Star Set Together



1. There are 12 patchwork blocks with one cream block embroidered in the center. The solids are formed with blue and cream fabric listed below.
2. We used 38" or 1 1/8 yards of Blue medium star fabric. Cut Fabric into 3, 12 1/2" strips to make 8 blue squares.
  - a. Cut 4 of these in half diagonally making 8 triangles.
3. 25" Cream Colored fabric makes the other half of these star triangles. Cut into 4, 12 1/2" squares, cut on the diagonal and sewn to blue triangles above. Set together to form star.
4. You can decide the width of the borders to make the quilt whatever size you choose. These blocks are 12, 12.5 unfinished blocks make about a 60" x 60" quilt.

### Sashing with Cornerstones.

1. 2 yards Blue medium star fabric. Cut Fabric 4" wide, to make 17 strips.  
Cornerstones: 1/4 yard or 2, 4" pieces to make 20 cornerstones.
2. Cornerstones: 1/4 yard or 2, 4" pieces to make 20 cornerstones.
3. This makes a small quilt topper, or the top of your bed or wallhanging, about 50" x 64".
