

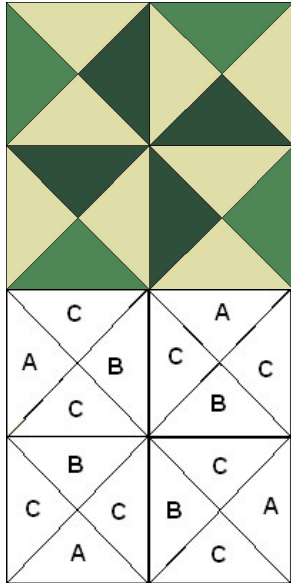


2005 Row 9

Block 12

Yankee Puzzle

12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.

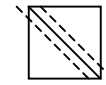


- Sew seams away from the center piece.
- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Lay out block pieces as cut, following diagram if necessary.
- Dry Press seams away from center. Move iron in one direction only, lift and press from center out to edges. Never iron back and forth, you are pressing seams not ironing wrinkles. Do not use steam until block is finished, water resets and distorts natural cotton fibers.
- Chain-sew when possible and use an anchor or tail to prevent thread nesting on bobbin side.

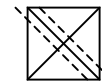
Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting measurements

Row 9: Make 7 blocks

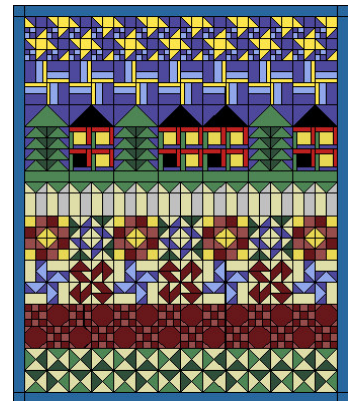
- A. Light Green = 1 square 7 1/4",
Blocks: 1 = 7 1/4" sq.; 2 = 7 1/4" x 15" 5 = 7.25" x 42"; 7 = 15" x 42"
- B. Dark Green = 1 square 7 1/4",
Blocks: 1 = 7 1/4" sq.; 2 = 7 1/4" x 15" 5 = 7.25" x 42"; 7 = 15" x 42"
- C. Cream = 2 squares 7 1/4"
Blocks: 1 = 7 1/4" x 15" 2 = 7 1/4" x 30" 5 = 15" x 42"; 7 = 7/8 yard



Assembly Make 4, 2 point triangle patches.



1. Cut out all squares.
 - a. Draw line down center diagonal of all C squares.
2. Place one Cream A with each of the green blocks.
 - a. Sew down 1/4" on each side of draw line, on both patches.
 - b. Cut "X" along solid diagonal lines. Stitch down dashed lines.
3. Sew AC, and BC 2 point triangles together to make 4-patches.
4. Press and lay out block following diagram.
5. Sew block halves together.
 - a. Be careful and match center points.
 - b. Press seams toward outside edges (toward goose points).



Quilt Row Assembly

Sew Yankee Puzzles (Block 12) together to make 12.5" x 84.5" unfinished Row 7. Assemble rows as desired or in order of quilt.

1. Sew rows together in desired order. Measure quilt it should be about 84.5" x 102.5".
 - a. You will need 1 yard for the last outside border.
2. Cut 10 or 11 strips 3 1/2" wide.
 - a. Sew 2 sections of 2 together. Measure the width (84.5") Cut them the same length and sew on the top and bottom of quilt making it 108" long.
 - b. Measure the length of quilt (108").
 - c. Sew 2 1/2 or 3 strips together to make 2 sets the right length. Sew these on the sides of quilt.
 - d. Miter corners if desired, you will need an extra 4" on each corner of all four sides or 8"/strip.
3. Backing should be 90" x 108" or about 6 yards 45" wide or 3 yards 90" wide.
4. Binding will take 3/4 - 1 yard of fabric. Free Bias Binding Instructions available at www.apatterngal.com.
