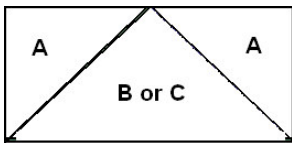
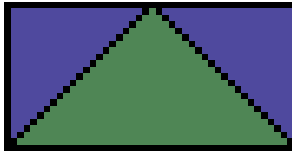

2005 Row 3 attach to Row 4

Block 3

Roofs & Tree Tops

6 x 12" finished block, 6.5" x 12 1/2" unfinished block.



- Sew seams away from the center piece.
- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Lay out block pieces as cut, following diagram if necessary.
- Dry Press seams away from center. Move iron in one direction only, lift and press from center out to edges. Never iron back and forth, you are pressing seams not ironing wrinkles. Do not use steam until block is finished, water resets and distorts natural cotton fibers.
- Chain-sew when possible and use an anchor or tail to prevent thread nesting on bobbin side.

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting measurements

Row 3: Make 4 black and 3 Green.



A. Blue All blocks = 2 triangles cut from 6 7/8" square.

Blocks 1 = 7" sq.; 2 = 14" x 7"; 5 = 1/4 yard; 7 = 7" x 42" + 7" x 7" sq.

B. Green = 3 Blocks = 1 square 13 1/2" (Cut "X").

Blocks 1 = 6.5" x 13.5"; 2 = 27" x 6.5"; 4 = 13.5" x 13.5

C. Black = 4 Blocks = 1 square 13 1/2" (Cut "X").

Blocks 1 = 6.5" x 13.5"; 2 = 27" x 6.5"; 4 = 13.5" x 13.5 8 Blocks = 14" x 28"

Assembly Sewn on Bias, Do not Stretch.

1. You are making large flying geese blocks for the roof (Black C) and tree tops (Green B). This square should be 6.5" x 12.5" before it is sewn into the quilt.
2. Cut triangles as shown in diagrams above.
3. Place long side of a blue corner to a short side of either black or green. Chain sew down each roof or tree top.
4. Open fabric and press if desired.
5. Place the other long side of blue corner down the other short side. Chain sew down each roof or tree top.

Quilt Row Assembly

Sew these together only after attaching to larger Row 4 Blocks. Attach these roofs and tree tops to each individual block (green with pine tree block 3 and black roof to house block 4) making 7 individual 18.5" x 12.5" unfinished blocks.

Then sew large blocks together to form row 18.5" x 84".
