

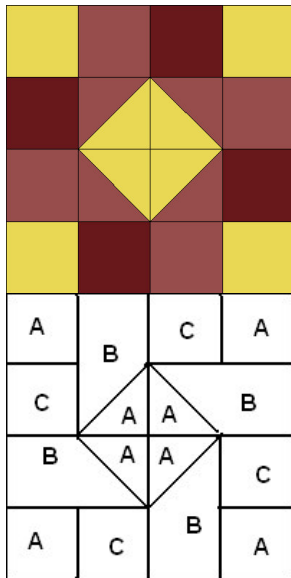


2005 Row 6

Block 7

Suzannah

12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.



- Sew seams away from the center piece.
- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Lay out block pieces as cut, following diagram if necessary.
- Dry Press seams away from center. Move iron in one direction only, lift and press from center out to edges. Never iron back and forth, you are pressing seams not ironing wrinkles. Do not use steam until block is finished, water resets and distorts natural cotton fibers.
- Chain-sew when possible and use an anchor or tail to prevent thread nesting on bobbin side.

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting measurements

Half Row 6: Make 4 blocks

A. Yellow - 4 corners and 4 centers = 8 squares, 3 1/2".

Blocks: 1 = 3 1/2" x 28"; 2 = 6 1/2" x 28"; 4 = 15" x 42"; 7 = 1/2 yd

B. Maroon = 4 rectangles 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".

Blocks: 1 = 3 1/2" x 28"; 2 = 6 1/2" x 28"; 4 = 15" x 42"; 7 = 1/2 yd

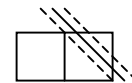
C. Brick Red = 4 squares, 3 1/2".

Blocks: 1 = 3 1/2" x 14"; 2 = 3 1/2" x 28"; 4 = 8" x 28"; 7 = 1/3 yd

Assembly

Row 6: 4 Blocks make half row.

1. Cut out A & B Yellow squares and Maroon rectangles.
2. Place C (Brick Red Fabric) face up at machine, and sew 4, A 3 1/2" squares onto it.
 - a. Butt each piece of fabric next to the previous fabric square.
 - b. Tighten stitch length or back stitch three stitches at the beginning and ending of each new fabric square. Sew seams away from center.
 - c. Carefully cut in between each block down the length of strip.
 - d. This is the bottom of each four patch.
3. Sew half of flying goose, using B rectangle and A square.
 - a. Draw line down center diagonal of all 3 1/2" squares. (Draw extra 1/2" line away from center to sew and save time and fabric scraps).
 - b. Sew down each draw line and trim away extra leaving 1/4" seam allowance.
 - c. Sew on the right hand corner only to make half goose.
4. Sew BA half goose to AC squares.
5. Press seams (away from center or toward goose points).
6. Lay out block according to diagram and sew 2 squares together to create half block.
7. Sew block halves together.



Quilt Row Assembly

Sew Blocks 7 Suzannah (4) and Balkan Puzzle (3) Block 8 together to make 12.5" x 84.5" unfinished Row 6. Assemble rows as desired or in order of quilt.
