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12" Block Sashing or Star Quilt Measurements

I. Fussy Cut Rose Cornerstones.

Finished Quilt Approximately 60" x 80"

With Cream Border around 12 blocks, and green sashing between blocks and fussy cut rose cornerstones in sashing.

A. Cream or White on Cream fabric: 1 1/3 yards cut into 16 strips 2 1/2" or 3" wide.

1. Press and measure each block.
2. If there is a 1" variance in the size of your blocks the smallest blocks will need to have 3" borders. Each 12 1/2" block takes 56" for borders. 12 1/2" blocks should be bordered in 2 1/2" sashing.
3. Square up all blocks to exactly 16".

B. Fussy Cut Roses: 2, 4" strips, cut in 6 & 4 of a kind (single or triple roses) 4" sq.

1. You will use 6 of the same roses in the center cornerstones.
2. Use 4 of the same roses in the outside border cornerstones.

C. Green Leaves, sashing & outside border: 1 2/3 yards cut into 14, 4" strips.

1. Cut 17 strips, 4 x 16. These are the center sashing.
2. Lay out quilt blocks and center sashing and cornerstones.
 - a. Sew sashing between rows of blocks.
 - b. Sew sashing and cornerstone rows.
 - c. Sew rows together matching seams at cornerstones and sashing.
3. Measure width of quilt.
 - a. Sew the same length strip on top and bottom of quilt.
4. Measure length of quilt.
 - a. Sew on cornerstones and make strip the same length as quilt.
 - b. Sew last outside border matching cornerstones and sashing.

D. Back Fabric: 3 1/3 yards of 45" wide fabric or 2 1/4 yards of 60" wide fabric.



II. Queen Size Star approximately 90x108

Cream block borders: 1 1/2 yards for borders around 13 blocks.

Main Color: 66" or 1 7/8 yards: Cut into 8, 16.5" squares.

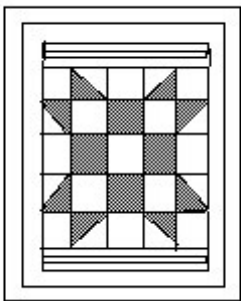
Alternate Color: 1 yard: Cut into 4, 16.5" sqrs. cut diagonally across bias.

Checkerboard Top & Bottom: 3/4 yard of 2 colors, cut into 7, 3 3/4" strips.

Inside Picture Frame Border: 1 yard, cut into 9 strips 3 3/4" wide.

Outside Picture Frame Border: 1 1/8 yard, cut into 10 strips 3 3/4" Wide.

Backing approximately 6 yards.



1. Follow instructions above A. to finish pieced blocks.
2. Cut 4 blocks of the main color diagonally across bias as you have done with alternate border.
3. Sew alternate and main color triangles together along the bias edge. Be careful and don't stretch.
4. Lay out quilt blocks. Using solid blocks on the main color and triangle blocks to form star around pieced blocks.
5. Checkerboard borders on top and bottom. Sew 4 strips together alternating colors.
 - a. Cut these into 3 3/4" squares. Sew blocks together to form 24 squares across.
 - b. Make 6 checkerboard rows. Sewing 3 rows together for top and bottom.
6. Measure quilt.
 - a. Sew on inside border top and bottom pieces, making sure you use the same length fabric.
 - b. Measure quilt and sew on sides of inside borders. Again sew strips together to make them the same length.
7. Measure quilt width and sew on outside borders as above. Making opposite sides equal as above. Sew the top and bottom first and then the outside left and right borders.
