



## Log Cabin Variations 12

## Cabin in a Cabin

12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.



- Sew seams away from the center piece.
- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Press seams away from center.

### Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting measurements

#### House

Yellow Cut 1 square, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

Pink multi-leaves House: Cut 2 sq. 1 1/2" x 1 1/2", Cut 2, 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Roof – Pink: Cut 1 strip, 2" x 6 1/2"

Light 1 –Wight On Cream: Sky: Cut 2 sq., 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" (Roof attachment)

Light 1: Cut 2 strips 2" x 3 1/2"

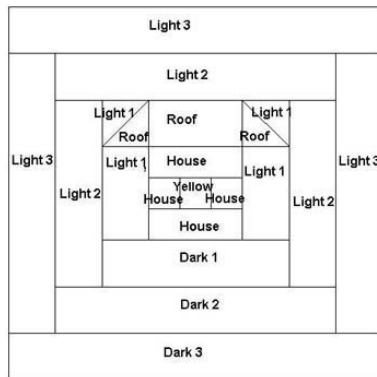
Light 2: Cut 2 strips, 2" x 6 1/2" and Cut 1 strip, 2" x 9 1/2"

Light 3: Cut 2 strips, 2" x 9 1/2", and 1 strip, 2" x 12 1/2"

Dark 1 – multi leaves on green: (lightest) Cut 1 strip, 2" x 6 1/2"

Dark 2 (medium) Cut 1 strip, 2" x 9 1/2"

Dark 3 (darkest) Cut 1 strip, 2" x 12 1/2"



### Assembly

1. House:
  - a. Sew 2 small squares on left and right side of center yellow window. Then sew 2 3 1/2" squares to the top and bottom of cabin.
  - b. Sew 2 sky colored L1 to sides of house.
  - c. Sew 2 small squares (L1) onto the corner of the roof on diagonal. Trim away all but 1/4" seam allowance.
  - d. Sew D1 to the bottom of the house. At this point block should measure 6 1/2" square.
2. Continue sewing in "+" sign Courthouse steps method. Top and bottom, left and right. 2 lights and 2 darks alternating around center. Through 2<sup>nd</sup> set and 3<sup>rd</sup> set.
