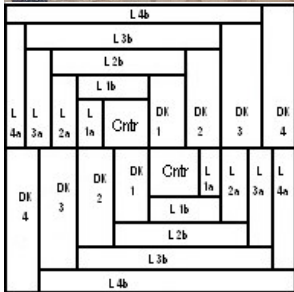




Log Cabin Variations 10

Offset "C" Fan Log Cabin

12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.



- Sew seams away from the center piece.
- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Press seams away from center.

Sewing Order and Cutting measurements

Center Large Floral: Fussy cut 2 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

(Cut Two of Each)

Light WOC 1a: 2 Strips 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Light WOC 1b: 2 Strips 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Dark 1 Pink multi leaves: 2 Strips 2" x 3 1/2"

Light WOC 2a: 2 Strips 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Light WOC 2b: 2 Strips 1 1/2" x 6"

Dark 2 Pink Leaves: 2 Strips 2" x 4 1/2"

Light WOC 3a: 2 Strips 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Light WOC 3b: 2 Strips 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

Dark 3 Lavender multi-leaves: 2 Strips 2" x 5 1/2"

Light WOC 4a: 2 Strips 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Light WOC 4b: Strips 1 1/2" x 11"

Dark 4 Purple leaves: 2 Strips 2" x 6 1/2"

Sewing Instructions:

Complete two halves of block separately, each half forming a "C" around the center square, then sewing the 2 pieces together. Each line above indicates one rotation around center, using 3 pieces only.

This block is easiest when pieced using the log cabin strip sewing method. (Lay down the strip face up in front of you and place the last piece sewn face down on the strip).

1. Sew pieces in above order. Remember you aren't sewing on the 4th piece around the center.
 - a. Center: L1a, L1b, Dk1. Stop and go back to the first light piece! Sew L2a, L2b, DK2. Stop and return to second light. Continue sewing the rest of the colors in this manner.
2. Lay out pieces. You should have 2 "C" shaped fans. The centers are kiddy-corner forming a bow-tie on an angle in the center of the block.
 - a. The only seam that will match is the center and 1st Dark seam line on each block.
